CONSTRUCTION SPEED ZONE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS DURING CONSTRUCTION ON A PORTION OF FM 359 WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF PATTISON AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation has made it known to the City of Pattison that operations will begin in the near future to overlay pavement along FM 359, and;

WHEREAS, in the interest of safety, it is desirable to maintain a construction speed zone during the construction period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATTISON that a construction speed zone be established along FM 359 from Pattison North City Limit to Pattison South City Limit, a distance of approximately 1.647 miles 35 MPH to be effective when so signed within said zone.

Necessary signs for posting the speed zones will be furnished, installed, and maintained by the direction of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation engineer in charge of the project.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200).

This ordinance shall be in effect only during the period of construction, and completion of this project shall automatically cancel the speed zones.
