

## RESOLUTION

### FOR ADOPTION OF THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN – 2011 UPDATE FOR THE H-GAC REGION

**WHEREAS**, certain areas of the City of Pattison are subject to periodic flooding and other natural hazards with the potential to cause damages to people properties within the area; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pattison desires to prepare and mitigate for such circumstances; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Action Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, the cities and counties in the H-GAC Region, in order to meet this requirement, have initiated development of a regional, multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, including the City of Pattison;

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved**, that the Pattison City Council hereby:

Adopts the Houston-Galveston Area council – Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update; and

Vests City Secretary (Official, Office or Agency) with the responsibility, authority, and means to:


- (a) Inform all concerned parties of this action.
- (b) Develop an addendum to this Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 update if H-GAC's, a city's, a county's, or a district's unique situation warrants such an addendum.


Appoints Mayor Bill Matthews (official, Office, of Agency) to assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update be reviewed at least annually and that any needed adjustment to the City of Pattison's addendum to the Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update be developed and presented to the Pattison City Council for consideration.

Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update.
