



Ordinance No. 115

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS ADOPTING ANY CURRENT OR FUTURE BURN BANS ENFORCED BY WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Waller County, by and through the County Fire Marshall, is authorized to declare a County wide ban on burning to protect the environment, promote public health and safety and to avoid nuisance conditions;

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Pattison declares it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Pattison, to adopt any current Waller County burn bans and to adopt any future burn bans that Waller County may enforce.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

Section A. Adopted.

1. That the City Council for the City of Pattison adopts any current Waller County burn bans and adopts, any future burn bans enforced by Waller County.

Section B. Enforcement.


1. The Fire Chief for the City of Pattison Volunteer Fire Department, or a designee of the City appointed by the Mayor shall have the authority to enforce any and all provisions of this ordinance.
2. Any person in violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).

Section C. Adoption of ordinance.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval and passage.


